

Community Service Information for Incoming Maggie Walker Freshmen



Dear Incoming Freshman Student:

Welcome to Maggie Walker! I look forward to working with you over the next four years as your Community Service Coordinator. I promise to work hard to make this process as simple and stress-free as possible. If you ever have questions regarding the Maggie Walker Community Service Program, please ask me for assistance.

In a nutshell, every Maggie Walker student is given the task of completing 140 hours of community service during their four years (35 hours a year). Students are allowed to earn a maximum of 70 of their hours on the Maggie Walker Campus with Maggie Walker organizations. Students must then earn a minimum of 70 hours off campus; it is acceptable to earn all 140 hours off campus.

As students earn community service hours, they will submit them on the x2vol online system. Each freshman will receive an email that provides instructions on how to log into the system and how to record their hours. If students have already earned some community service hours over the summer, they should wait until they receive the email for accessing x2vol to enter their account and submit their hours.

Please read over the information that can be found on x2vol and the additional handout provided in this packet. You can also find additional information on the Community Service Group found on the Schoology Site.

As you can imagine, Covid-19 is impacting the way in which we earn, verify, approve, and think about community service hours. I am currently working with Maggie Walker Administration to consider the best ways to handle community service during this time, and I plan to be as flexible as possible as we move forward. Please know that I am here to help you, and that you can always reach out to me if you have questions.
